# Message from the Chairman

IGAS 2022 was held for the first time in four years, as many exhibitions were cancelled due to the spread of COVID-19. The exhibition was held in Halls 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6 of the East Halls of Tokyo Big Sight, with 218 exhibitors in 1,876 booth units. Visitors numbered 33,078 over five days.

This year's IGAS 2022 featured a variety of events under the theme of "Venture into the innovation!"

IGAS LIVE TV featured freelance announcer Miho Ohashi as the special navigator, and included IGAS Topics, which introduced DAILY NEWS articles published every morning, IGAS Top Interviews, which interviewed exhibiting company executives, and IGAS Viewpoint, which introduced the theme zones by visiting the exhibition halls live on the official IGAS website. In addition, the same content was broadcast on large monitors installed in the galleria, bringing the entire exhibition to life.

The PANEL DISCUSSION and TOUR have become popular events at IGAS. Although the number of participants was lower than the previous show due to measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the archived video was broadcasted on the official website.

As with the previous exhibition, the Japan Printing Exhibition showcased all prizewinning works from various competitions held by the Japan Federation of Printing Industries and 10 member organizations for calendars, catalogs, bookbinding

design, packages, etc.

In the INNOVATIVE BUSINESS ZONE, exhibitors jointly exhibited and gave demonstrations to small and medium-sized printing companies, print buyers, and brand owners, offering tips for expanding their printing business.

Other events that were held included SMART FACTORY IGAS 2022 and Flexo Japan 2022.

Although the number of exhibitors and visitors at this year's IGAS 2022 was lower than the previous show due to the increase in COVID-19 infections leading to uncertainty regarding events like this, we were able to make our presence felt as a symbol of the revival of the printing industry in anticipation of the pandemic's end. We would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for their support and cooperation.

Based on the results of IGAS 2022, we will do our utmost to meet your expectations for the next IGAS, and we look forward to your continued cooperation.

IGAS 2022, the International Graphic Arts Show, was based on in-person exhibitions, but also incorporated new styles such as virtual events, and provided information covering all processes from pre-press to post-press through discussions, seminars, tours, theme zones, and other events.

"Innovation" in the unifying theme "Venture into the innovation!" is a key word in the fields of pre-press and digital printing, which are the main areas our association is involved in.

At IGAS 2022, various proposals were made toward the construction of an optimal production environment, including collaboration among companies; despite the COVID-19 pandemic, 33,078 people visited the show.

As the theme of this year's exhibition suggests, the event provided an opportunity to find a new direction for the printing business.

Specifically, digital printing presses with improved productivity and quality, integrated workflows that link printing to delivery, and technological innovations such as Al and robots have pushed the implementation of smart factories forward in the printing industry.

The relevance of the field of digital printing presses has been increasing in tandem with improvements to functionality and quality, and the shift to total solutions with stronger linkage to post-press has progressed, now expanding into the field of flexible packaging.

Meanwhile, in the pre-press and workflow fields, the production flow from digital and offset presses to post-press has been optimized and visualized, and the integration of processes such as pre-press, printing, post-press, and delivery has been improving steadily.

In addition, proposals related to AI and robotics received a greater response than expected at IGAS. The recognition of these technologies as issues to be addressed by the printing industry was also a trend at this year's IGAS.

We will continue to contribute to the revitalization and development of printing media and the printing industry as a whole by providing products, services, and solutions that meet the needs of the printing industry while responding to the changing market environment.

We look forward to your continued guidance and encouragement.
