Japan Printing Machinery Association and Japan Association of Pre-Press & Digital Printing Systems Suppliers are going to hold IGAS2027 (International Graphic Arts Show) for five days from Thursday, August 5 through Monday, August 9, 2027 at Tokyo Big Site.

The coming IGAS2027 will be the first exhibition in five years due to the large-scale renovation of Tokyo Big Sight. The global social and economic situation is faced with heightened uncertainty and many difficult problems. When it comes to the Japanese economy, a steady economic recovery continues although its situation remains severe, and reforms represented by key words such as DX (Digital transformation) and GX (Green transformation) are underway.

IGAS2027 is going to propose the latest technologies, services, and solutions in printing and cross-media printing and the creation thereby of new business, providing occasions for active business interactions. Above all, it is intended to be a trade show that will present the current status of the printing industry which underwent transformation in these five years to visitors from home and abroad. Specifically, a variety of content will be live-streamed, by a celebrity host, at the official IGAS website and in the exhibition hall, as “IGAS LIVE TV+”. Guided tours that actually walk through the exhibition halls will be conducted as “Tour.” Those guided tours will be planned for a variety of categories and themes. Such tour courses will be offered that let visitors get the bird’s-eye view of the show. Those tours will provide optimal opportunities for exhibitors to advertise their products, technology, and services. We will make efforts to increase the number of visitors including international visitors.

Terms of Application IGAS2027

1. Purpose of the Exhibition

The International Graphic Arts Show (IGAS) is a comprehensive international trade show on print media which showcases the latest products, technology, and services related to printing, bookbinding, paper converting, packaging, digital graphics and digital communications. It provides visitors with new vision of the future of print media industry by presenting the latest technology and various solutions. The show also provides exhibitors with excellent international business opportunities and contributes to the invigoration and development of the printing and related industries.

2. Eligibility for Exhibitors

Corporations, individuals, or organizations/bodies engaged in designing, manufacturing, and sales of products defined in “Article 3 Exhibits” below, and those who are approved by the organizer, Japan Printing Machinery Association (JPMA) to participate in the exhibition.
JPMA may request the applicant to submit relevant documents to confirm the eligibility as an exhibitor.

3. Exhibits

Exhibits allowed to be shown at the exhibition are :

- machines, systems and materials for design, prepress, printing, bookbinding, paper-converting, packaging, seal-label, etc.
- software, systems and technologies for digital communication by electronic media.
- products and technologies originated in print technology.
- services and solutions relating to those.

4. Participation Fee

(1) Participation fee per booth unit is as follows:

Notes:

- A Japanese entity of a foreign enterprise or an agent of a foreign enterprise is not considered as an “Overseas Exhibitor”.
- Environment friendly system panels (consisting of panel board, pole and beam) will be used as partition walls for booth separation. The net, size of each booth unit will be 2.97m x 2.97m.

(2) Early Application Discount

For applications submitted by October 30, 2026 (note: Japan standard time. All dates and times hereinafter are based on Japan Standard time), the following discount rate will be applied according to the number of units. For application for additional units, whether the discount rate will be applied or not will be decided depending on the date of additional application.

(3) Participation Fee includes the followings:

- 1) Usage fee for occupying the allocated space during the exhibition and move-in/move-out periods.

- 2) Exhibitor passes effective during the term of exhibition and move-in/move-out periods. (Details to be specified separately.)
- 3) Free invitation tickets. (50 tickets per booth unit)
- 4) listing on the official website.

5. Application Period

- (1) JPMA will accept applications from October 29, 2025 (Wednesday) to December 18, 2026 (Friday). Applications by postal mail must arrive at JPMA by December 18, 2026 (Friday).
- (2) Applications including additional order received on and after December 19, 2026 (Saturday) will be placed on a waiting list. JPMA will notify the applicants respectively when and if space becomes available.
- (3) Applications including additional order received on and after December 19, 2026 (Saturday) will be added 10% of extra cost to the participation and co-exhibitor fee.

6. Application Procedures

- (1) Overseas applicants are required to duly complete the application forms and send the forms directly to the following office by postal mail, E-mail, or fax.
- (2) Concurrently with submission of the application form, JPY 29,000 (twenty nine thousand – VAT included) per unit of requested space shall be remitted to one of the following bank accounts as non-refundable deposit. **All bank transfer fees, if any, are to be borne by the applicant.**
- (3) In case of joint application where two or more applicants wish to exhibit in the same booth, one principal applicant shall be selected. The principal applicant shall be responsible for fulfilling the application procedures and payment of various expenses including the participation fee. In such case, JPY 61,000 (sixty one thousand – VAT included) per co-exhibitor other than the principal applicant must be added to the deposit.
- (4) If the remittance of deposit cannot be acknowledged, or if the application form is not filled in properly or the application procedures are not satisfactory for any other reason, JPMA will not accept the application.

7. Acceptance and Exhibition Agreement

- (1) JPMA will review contents of the applications, receipt of the deposit and eligibility for exhibitor by December 18, 2026 (Friday). Then, JPMA will notify the permitted applicants in writing of acceptance. (Hereinafter an applicant who has received a notice of acceptance is called an Approved Applicant)
- (2) Exhibition Agreement shall take effect from the date the written notice of acceptance is sent out from JPMA, and Approved Applicants shall be under obligation to pay the Participation Fee from this time onwards.
- (3) JPMA will notify those applicants who are not approved by written notice and reimburse the deposit to the bank account specified by the applicant.

8. Exhibition Space Adjustment

- (1) JPMA reserves the right to adjust the number of units in consideration of the capacity of accommodation or the number of applications. JPMA will notify the applicant affected by this adjustment in writing by January 29, 2027 (Friday).
- (2) JPMA will not accept cancellation or modification by the Approved Applicant for reasons resulting from the abovementioned adjustment, except in cases where JPMA agrees with that the applicant cannot achieve his/her intended exhibit due to the adjustment. If JPMA approves the cancellation of the application, the deposit and the co-exhibitor fee, if any, will be reimbursed to the applicant.

9. Payment of Participation Fee

- (1) Approved Applicants shall pay the Participation Fee minus paid-up deposit amount by remittance to the designated bank account (same bank account used for deposit payment) no later than February 26, 2027 (Friday). (Hereinafter an Approved Applicant who has paid full amount of Participation Fee is called an Exhibitor)
- (2) If the Approved Applicant fails to remit the remaining amount of Participation Fee by the abovementioned payment deadline, JPMA shall determine that the Participation Agreement had been cancelled and revoke the approval of participation. JPMA will treat the paid-up deposit as a part of the cancellation penalty and shall have the right to charge the Approved Applicant to pay the remaining amount of Participation Fee.

10. Space Allocation

- (1) **JPMA will decide space allocation at its discretion and notify the Approved Applicant/Exhibitor of the decision. The Approved Applicant/Exhibitor cannot refuse or request modification of the allocated space decided by JPMA.**
- (2) The Approved Applicant/Exhibitor shall not sell, mortgage, transfer or lend all or part of the allocated space to a third party. Without written approval from JPMA, an Approved Applicant/Exhibitor shall not exchange the allocated space with another Approved Applicant/Exhibitor.

11. Cancellation / Space Reduction

- (1) Approved Applicant/Exhibitor shall not cancel nor reduce the space except if the Approved Applicant/Exhibitor submits notice of cancellation or space reduction in writing, and JPMA approves. Even when JPMA accepts cancellation or space reduction, the following penalty will be imposed on the Approved Applicant/Exhibitor.

On and after March 1, 2027 (Monday)	100% of Ordinary Participation Fee (including co-exhibitor fee)

(*1) In case of space reduction, equivalent amount to the reduced space will be the penalty.

- (2) If JPMA approves the cancellation or space reduction notice from the Approved Applicant/Exhibitor, JPMA will treat the paid-up deposit as part of penalty and shall have the right to charge such Approved Applicant/Exhibitor to pay the remaining amount of penalty defined in the chart above.
- (3) If the Exhibitor does not start to occupy the allocated space without prior notice by August 3, 2027 (Tuesday) (two days prior to the opening date of the exhibition), JPMA reserves the right to cancel the Exhibition Agreement without notice or demand. Consequently, the Exhibitor shall lose the right to use the allocated space. In such case, the Exhibitor cannot receive reimbursement of the Participation Fee, and cannot demand any compensation for loss or damage from JPMA.

12. Listing on the official website

Although the exhibition host will make an utmost effort in ensuring the accuracy of information contained in the official website in issuing or creating it, the host is not responsible for any error or omission therein.

13. Security of Exhibits

JPMA shall not be liable for any damage or theft of exhibits/decorations, or injury to Exhibitors or visitors or any other relevant persons, due to the occurrence of any event beyond JPMA's control such as natural disaster, acts of God.

14. Compensation for Damages, Liability Insurance by the Exhibitor

- (1) The Exhibitor shall take full responsibility for any damage of the facilities or the building structure of the venue, or injury to Exhibitors or visitors, when such damage or injury is caused by the Exhibitor, its agents, its representatives, or any other relevant persons.
- (2) The Exhibitor shall carry at his/her own expense sufficient comprehensive property insurance to cover damages for fire, disaster, theft, loss and damage, and liability insurance to cover damage and injury to third parties.

15. Restoration of Allocated Space

- (1) The Exhibitor shall restore the allocated space to its original condition by the date specified by JPMA as soon as the exhibition finishes. If JPMA determines that Exhibitor is unable to complete the restoration by the specified date, JPMA or a third party appointed by JPMA will restore the said space, and JPMA reserves the right to demand all expenses incurred by the restoration, including storage costs of the exhibits, on the Exhibitor.
- (2) JPMA or party appointed by JPMA shall not be liable for any damage or destruction of the exhibits unless it is proved that the damage or destruction is caused by gross negligence of JPMA or the appointed party.

- (3) If the expense described in the abovementioned clause (1) is not compensated by the Exhibitor, JPMA is entitled to sell the exhibits and other property in custody and apply the proceeds for payment of the expenses incurred. The exhibitor shall not have any right to raise objection to the calculation method of the sales price.

16. Observation of Terms and Regulations

- (1) The Exhibitor shall obey the procedures, rules & regulations and warnings, included in the “Exhibitor Manual” provided by JPMA, as well as in this “Terms of Application”. The Exhibitor shall follow any additional instructions given by JPMA and shall fully cooperate to ensure that the exhibition runs smoothly.
- (2) The Exhibitor shall follow the instructions from JPMA and shall be responsible for the payment of various charges throughout the term of the exhibition and move-in/move-out periods.
- (3) Display of exhibits and distribution of promotional materials shall be confined within the area of Exhibitor’s allocated booth.

17. Amicable Relation with Neighboring Exhibitors

The Exhibitor shall not disturb neighboring exhibitors by acoustic device or visual equipment etc. prepared for demonstration or booth effect. The Exhibitors are also encouraged to keep amicable relations with neighboring exhibitors throughout the term of the exhibition including move-in/move-out periods.

18. JPMA’s Rights

- (1) JPMA reserves the right to require the Exhibitor to remove from the booth or exhibition area the exhibits and decorations that are deemed by JPMA to be contrary to the purpose of the exhibition.
- (2) JPMA reserves the right to require the Exhibitor to remove the exhibits and decorations that are deemed to be against the public interest or infringe upon others’ rights such as intellectual property rights.
- (3) JPMA reserves the right to prohibit the Exhibitor or related personnel from making noises disturbing neighboring Exhibitors or any other inappropriate promotional activity.
- (4) JPMA reserves the right to take necessary actions against the Exhibitor or related personnel if the Exhibitor or related personnel breach any of the preceding clauses.
- (5) If the Exhibitor or related personnel does not obey JPMA’s instructions immediately, JPMA reserves the right to terminate the Exhibition Agreement and prohibit the use of the allocated space. In such case, JPMA will not reimburse the Participation Fee paid by the Exhibitor.
- (6) JPMA reserves the right to change the regulations and rules for the purpose of better operation.
- (7) JPMA reserves the right to make photographs, drawings and films of Exhibitor’s activities, ways of exhibition, and the exhibits themselves and to use such photographs, drawing and films for advertising purposes and for press publications. This also applies to photographs taken by the media with JPMA’s permission.
- (8) JPMA reserves the right to make final decisions concerning matters which are not specified in this “Terms of Application” and matters which are in doubt in consideration with the Purpose of the Exhibition.

19. Cancellation of Exhibition

JPMA may be forced to cancel the exhibition due to the causes beyond its control such as natural disaster, pandemic, force majeure, etc. If the exhibition is cancelled before the move-in start date (July 31, 2027 (Saturday)), JPMA will reimburse part of the Participation Fee after deducting the expenses already incurred to JPMA. JPMA shall not be responsible for any damage or expense incurred to the Exhibitors due to cancellation of the exhibition, regardless of the time of the cancellation.

20. Alteration of Duration and Opening Hours

- (1) JPMA reserves the right to alter the duration (including move-in/move-out periods) and opening hours for reasons beyond its control such as natural disaster or force majeure.
- (2) Approved Applicants/Exhibitors are not entitled to terminate or modify the Exhibition Agreement because of the alteration mentioned in the previous clause. JPMA shall not be responsible for any damage or occurrence/increase of expenses for the Exhibitor due to the alteration.

21. Exhibit under Patent and Utility Model Rights

Due to revisions made to the exhibition designation procedures by the Commissioner of Japan Patent Office, designation system will be abolished for exhibitions held on and after April 1, 2012. Exhibitors who wish to seek protection of industrial property rights prior to patent application for invention and design of exhibits within Japan under Japanese Patent Act Article 30, Paragraph 3 and Japanese Trademark Act Article 9, Paragraph 1, Clause 1 are required to take necessary action prior to participating in the Exhibition at their own responsibility.

22. Agreement of Jurisdiction

Any litigation which may arise between JPMA and an Exhibitor (including Applicants and Approved Applicants) in relation to the Exhibition Agreement shall fall within the jurisdiction of the Tokyo District Court in accordance with the laws of Japan. All related rules and regulations, including the clauses in this “Terms of Application” , shall be interpreted based on the Japanese language version.
